Digest of Educational Statistics – REF L11 .D48 Provides a compilation of statistical information covering the field of American Education.

Education and Sociology – REF LC189.95 .E38 2002 Provides information on key topics in the sociology of education.

Encyclopedia of Education – REF LB15 .E47 2003 A multi-volume set providing overviews of a wide range of educational topics, institutions, practices, and theories. Short selected bibliographies are provided for each topic.
